CARL: Program Allocation of Cache submitted to PLDI'20

- Designed a compiler driven lease-cache allocation algorithm and a theoretical result to show its optimality among all lease assignment algorithms.
- · Evaluation on Polybench suite shows that, compared with LRU and OPT cache replacement policy, our new policy could outperforms LRU and achieve almost the same as OPT.

PLUM: Static Cache Performance Analysis for OpenMP program Sep. 2018 - Present submitted to PPoPP'20

- · Analyzed cache performance for OpenMP programs during compile time.
- Evaluation on PolyBench suite shows that, compared with runtime instrumentation, our approach could reach 93.97% accuracy while reduce could speedup the analysis by 133.67% and 168.34% when sampling only 10% and 5% of the iteration space respectively.

- · Simulate a 32KB, read-only, direct-mapped instruction cache and a 32KB, 2-way set associative data cache among a working 5-stage pipeline.
- · Simulate a Alwasy-not-taken and Bimodal Branch Predictor among a working 12-stage pipeline.
- · Add Renaming Module, IssueQueue, Load/Store Queue, and Retire Buffer to transfer an in-order processor to an out-of-order processor.

Static Loop Parallelization

- Develop LLVM Function pass in C++ to detect loops and generate all array access expressions.
- · Implement LLVM Function pass to analyze the dependence relations, including find loop induction variables, distance vectors and direction vectors.
- · Print out all loops that could be parallelized.

- · Optimize the iOS Map SDK usage and eventually reduce nearly 56% memory consumption.
